

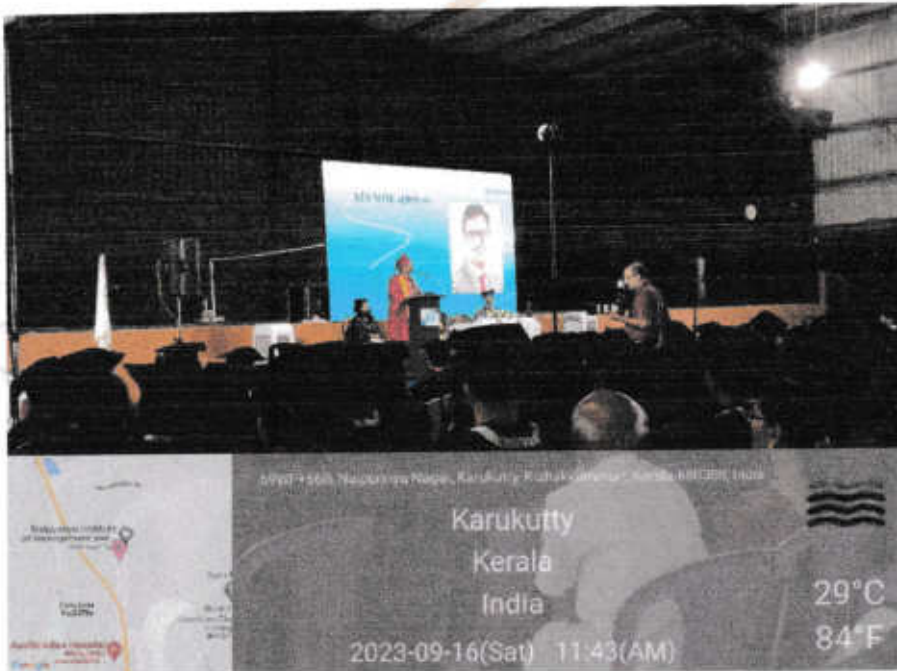


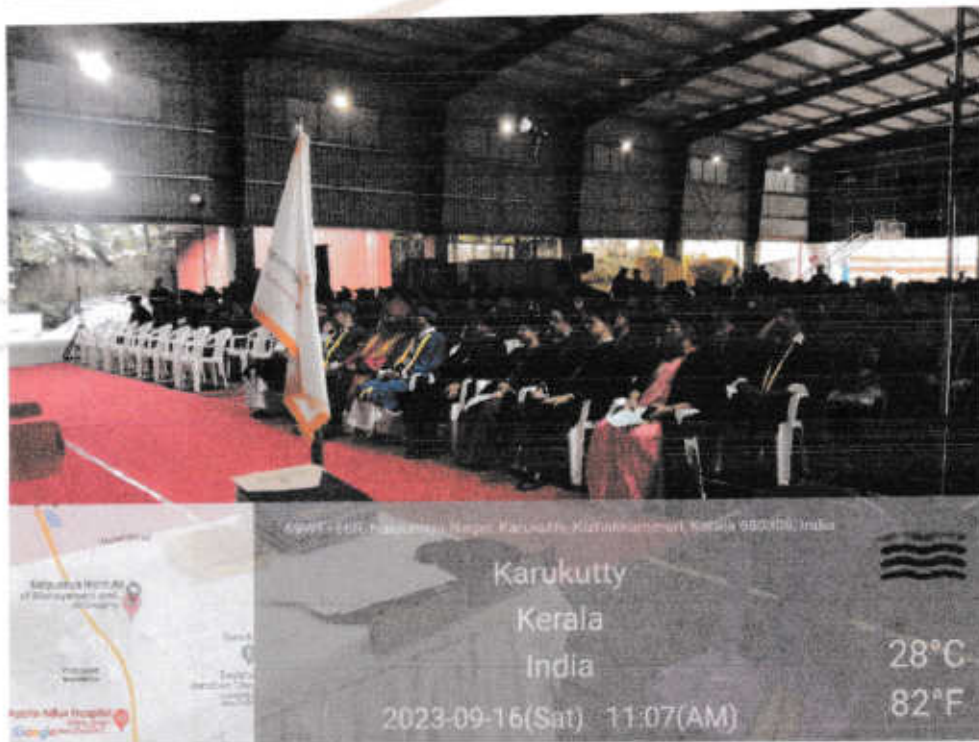

## The Academic Report of Post Graduate Batch 2021-2023

**The task of modern education is not to cut down jungles but to irrigate desert – C.S.Lewis**

**True education is concerned not only with practical goals but also with values.**

As this academic report for the Post Graduate Batch of 2021-23 is being presented, Naipunnya has completed 25 years of its inception and we recall the marvelous ways in which the college has fulfilled its mission in imparting education, moral and spiritual values and discipline to help build young leaders and dynamic managers who will hold themselves responsible for the development of the society. I am glad over the massive bearings during the past years especially when this PG batch of 2021-23 with 28 students under the three PG department were with their campus life at NIMIT.

The Covid-19 pandemic was exceedingly challenging for students especially as it pushed universities online to remote learning. The change was long overdue. Naipunnya Institute of Management and Information Technology, a Self-Financing College, accredited with NAAC B++ Grade and being ISO certified for Quality Education stood up to all the demands of time to keep up the benchmarks, ensuring the preparedness to adopt to situation and it was indeed a soft beginning to bring back students to offline classes. The batch 2021-23 started their academic pursuit with Shubharambh 2021, the initiation ceremony held on November 25,2021 followed by an orientation and induction sessions.

### Curricular Aspects: Teaching Learning and Evaluation

The teaching system was revamped as per the Choice Based Credit Semester System for Post Graduate Curriculum 2019 regulation for all PG Programmes affiliated to the University of Calicut, with the revised syllabus which came into effect for 2019 admission for the Programmes namely; M.Com. Finance, MA English Language and Literature and M.Sc.Computer Science. The curriculum includes core course, elective courses and ability enhancement courses. The comprehensive Viva-Voce and Project Work are the core course which was done towards the end of the semester during August 2023.

Total Credits for the Post graduate programme, inclusive of electives is 80.

- The specialization electives for M.Com. with Finance comprised of courses on Investment Management, Financial Markets and Institutions, International Finance and Advanced Strategic Financial Management.
- The elective courses for MA English Language and Literature comprised of Women's Writing, World Drama, Indian English Fiction and Dalit Studies.
- The elective courses for M.Sc. Computer Science comprised of Computer Graphics, Cryptography and Network Security, Web Engineering and Digital Image Processing.

The academic program objectives were aligned with audit courses as directed by UGC with a total of 8 credits aiming at ability enhancement and professional competency through writing skills and translation theory and practice for the students of the PG Department of English. Presentation – Publication of Research Paper and Live Project with Statistical Packages for the students of PG Department of Commerce and IT Research Projects and Publication for the PG Department of Computer Science.

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Assignments, seminars, discussions and class participation were the internal assessment components for evaluation. The students were continuously assessed through the internal examinations and viva-voce. The evaluations were followed with remedial measures and peer teaching support. University results of the three semesters declared till date have eventually proved very positive on the efforts put by the students.

### Curriculum Enrichment and Significant Achievements

Walk with scholar programme with advanced learners and Student Support Programme with remedial coaching were catered according to the need and requirement from time to time. Innovative methods and new contents in the curriculum were witnessed where in the students made right use of the openings by attending Faculty Exchange Programmes while they also participated in various seminars, workshops, inter-collegiate fest and competitions conducted by various associations keeping the academic year equally eventful and appealing. The students have excelled in doing projects and making presentations in national conferences and the faculty takes pride in the fact that their research represents a variety of disciplinary perspectives.

The PG Batch Commerce got an inordinate opportunity for an outbound programme to Christ University Lavasa, Pune, where the students had an exposure to the teaching learning environment under the 'CAMPUS CONNECT' initiative for a week where all students presented papers. They had an Industrial Visit to Katraj Dairy Farm, Pune. They also had an opportunity to visit the Securities and Exchange Board of India, Mumbai with a purpose of Investor Awareness and Education. During the two-year study period, students had presented research papers at the International Conference coordinated by the department and few publications were a part of the Kanpur Philosophers and Naivigyan Research Journals. Number of students attended the internship programme at ESAF. All students attended the two-day workshop on Fintech elaborating on the "Futures for Commerce" and the hands-on workshop on SPSS.

The P.G students from the Department of English have embarked on a remarkable journey of intellectual exploration, they had explored deep into the domains of Literature and language, critical thinking emerging as beacons of knowledge and creativity. Mr Jesbin Joseph took up as the student member to the Library Council of the NIMIT, assisting the college to bring improvements in the Learning Resource Facilities for students. In this pursuit of excellence these students had demonstrated unwavering commitment in Peer Teaching, National Seminar, One Book One Naipunnya, Department Fest (Chutney Soca), Inter - collegiate events, book publication and had also worked as Intern for the college. Mr. Jesbin Joseph published a book titled 'Riya' – Short story Collection. Mr. Abhinandh Janeesh published a Poetry Collection titled 'Aavarnaniyam'. The cultural visit to Biennale : Kochi-the international exhibition of contemporary art and festival was indeed a great insight for the batch.

The PG students of Computer Science successfully completed Google Certification in Fundamentals of Digital Marketing and Coursera Certification on Basics of Python (University of Michigan). The students published two papers each in the International Journal of Advanced Research in Science, Communication and Technology and Kanpur Philosophers respectively. The students also presented two papers in International conference organized by the college. A one-workshop on LaTeX was well participated by the students adding to a systematic knowledge to document preparation.

## Institutional Values

The students observed the relevant days through Morning Assemblies and 'SYNERGIA' The Class Forum. The PG Batches received a lot of appreciation for their creativity and were declared as the Best Performers for the Class Forum. AVANI- The Onam Celebration, SWARAJ- The Independence Day Celebration, NATIVITY – The Christmas Celebration and College Day were enjoyed in the true spirit of oneness with the support of the Student Council Body under the leadership of Mr. Abhinandh Janeesh of MA English who was the elected Chairperson of the Student Council for the academic year 2022-23. The study tour towards the end of the final semester was another exciting venture for all. VISMAYA- The Arts Day Celebration and VIVA- The Annual Sports Meet were very well participated by the students, bringing winning stories to script. Mr Arnold Babu had been acknowledged as the Best Book Lover for the year 2022. Mr Arjun M A, Mr Mohammed Asif, Mr Aswin Anto and Ms Athira Shaji brought glory to the institution by putting all their efforts in the various sports and games they represented at the state and national levels competition enabling our college to bag the overall fifth position in the university

Education doesn't prevent you from making mistakes but makes you learn from your mistakes and hence guidance and learning relationship to drive students to a more productive outcome was regularly organized by mentors using the Mentor-mate Software. Community services, outreach and extension activities were encouraged as IQAC initiative. The students were active members in many of the cells and clubs who responsibly took charge of the mental, physical and spiritual formation. More services had been added to the students in the area of extra-curricular activities and value inculcation as well as campus living with the training department through Skill Enhancement Programmes.
