### Report on Avani'23

Onam is celebrated to mark the homecoming of the King Mahabali who is believed to be the greatest king ever in Kerala. It is assumed that he rules the underworld as per the orders of Lord Vishnu and visits his subjects once in a year. This occasion, called Onam which for Malayalis all across the world, is an extravaganza. The festival of Onam brings along with it all the entire fabric of Kerala-its history, its culture, its beliefs. Designing of beautiful flower carpets called *Pookalam*, preparation of banquet lunch and the *Thiruvathirakkali* dance are the major attractions of this festival. Avani'23 was conducted for two days: 24th and 25th August 2023. It was inaugurated by our Principal & Executive Director, Rev. Fr. Dr. Paulachan K. J. on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2023, Thursday. After the inauguration, various competitions were conducted at *Navarang* auditorium from 9.30 a. m. to 12.45p. m. In the afternoon session, various fun games, tug of war, and Arm wrestling competitions were conducted.



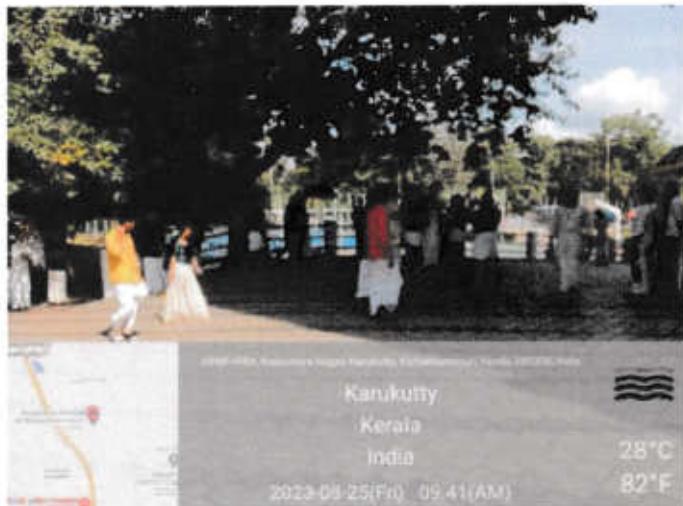

- Total weight of the team (Men section - 8 pullers) should not exceed 560 KG
- Total weight of the team (Women section - 8 pullers) should not exceed 400 KG
- The substituted player should weigh less than the player
- Weight will be measured 2 hours before the competition
- Participant's weight will only be measured once throughout the competition.
- All participants shall wear canvas shoes mandatorily
- The competition is being conducted in a freestyle manner
- Reverse pulling is not allowed
- Competitions are being conducted on the basis of Tug of War Federation Rules
- Competitions are conducted on the basis of Knockout
- The winner is decided through a Best of Three match
- The judge's decisions will be final

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## **PAYASAM MAKING COMPETITION(staff)**

### **Rules and Regulations:**

1. Maximum one team per department, a team would consist of two members.
2. Time allotted for the preparation and presentation is 2 hrs.
3. The participants have to bring their own ingredients as well as presentation items (crockery, cutlery, table cloth etc.) for the competition.
4. The participants need to prepare a minimum quantity for serving 2 people (Portion size- 2). One portion has to be set aside for the judging panel and the other for presentation.
5. The Payasam has to be prepared on the spot, no precooked ingredient is allowed in the competition.
6. Limited cooking utensils will be provided by the event organizers. If any special utensil is required for preparation, the same has to be brought by the participants.
7. Kitchen, worktable, and cooking utensils have to be cleaned before the presentation of the final dish.
8. The criteria for judgment are: Taste, Colour, Texture, Flavor, Presentation, and description of the dish.
9. Decision of the judges would be final.

### **Rules & Guidelines:**

- 1) The venue of competition will be the **classrooms in the Main block**, time will be from **9:00 am to 11:00**.
- 2) Competition will be **Class wise**.
- 3) Plastic bags are not allowed in the venue.
- 4) Your area where pookkalam should be made will be allotted by the student coordinators.
- 5) The pookkalam should have a circular geometric pattern while the measurement of the pookkalam should not exceed one metre in diameter.
- 6) Participating teams must use only fresh flowers and leaves to make the pookkalam, materials like coffee powder, sawdust, coloured dried coconut or coloured powder should not be used during the process of designing.
- 7) The pookkalam should be designed using petals of the flowers. (An exception is given, if the team wants to place a lotus in the centre of the pookkalam).
- 8) Theme or concept-based designs are allowed.
- 9) The teams shall consist of minimum five members and maximum 10 members, list should be submitted to the student coordinators before the competition.
- 10) The time allotted for designing the pookkalam is 1.5 hour and half an hour for cleaning the surroundings.
- 11) After the designing of Pookkalam is completed, the teams can decorate it with traditional decorations like the Nilavillaku or Onathappan etc.

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12) After the completion of the Pookalam, the teams should clean the surroundings and make it ready for judging.

13) Any misconduct or misbehavior of team members during the competition will result in disqualifying the team from the event.

Even though, these are the rules and regulations applied during the Pookalam designs, depending upon theregional interest, the rules can be changed. Participating teams should know time limit, number of participants, flowers to be used and other rules much prior to the competition
