

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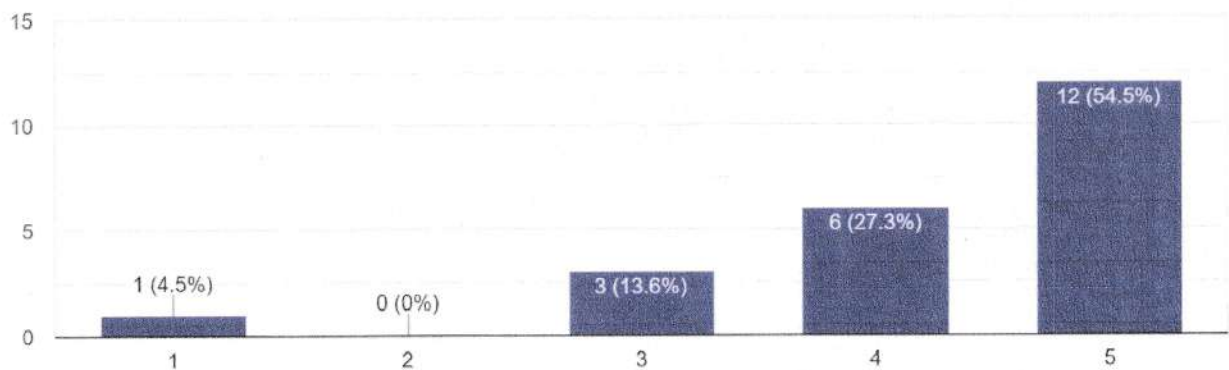
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FEEDBACK

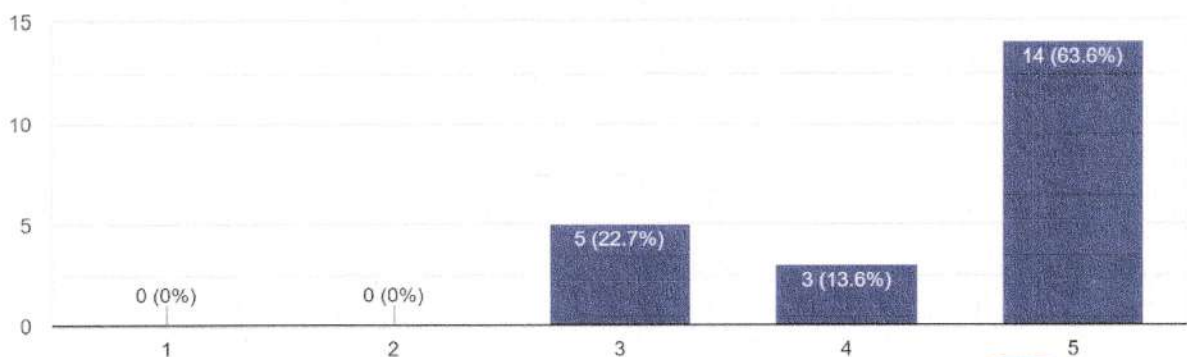
How satisfied are you with the session content?

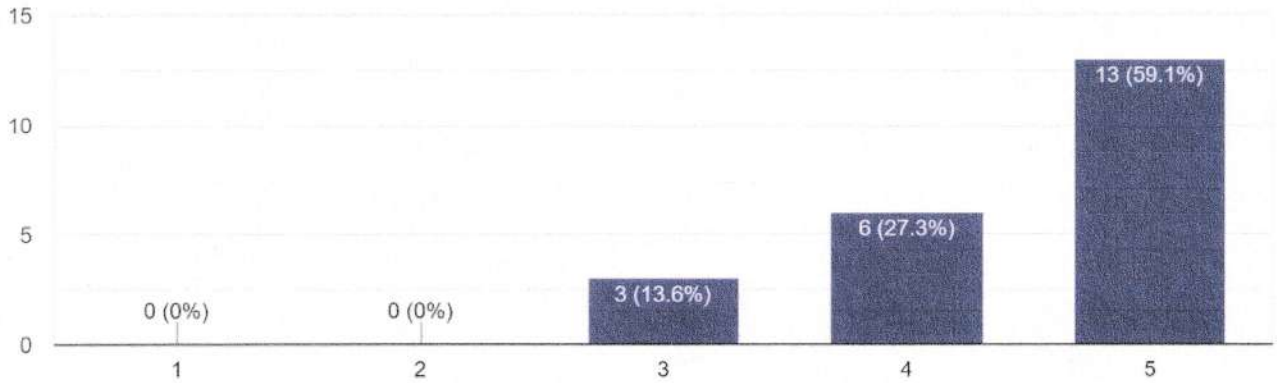
How do you evaluate the resource person?

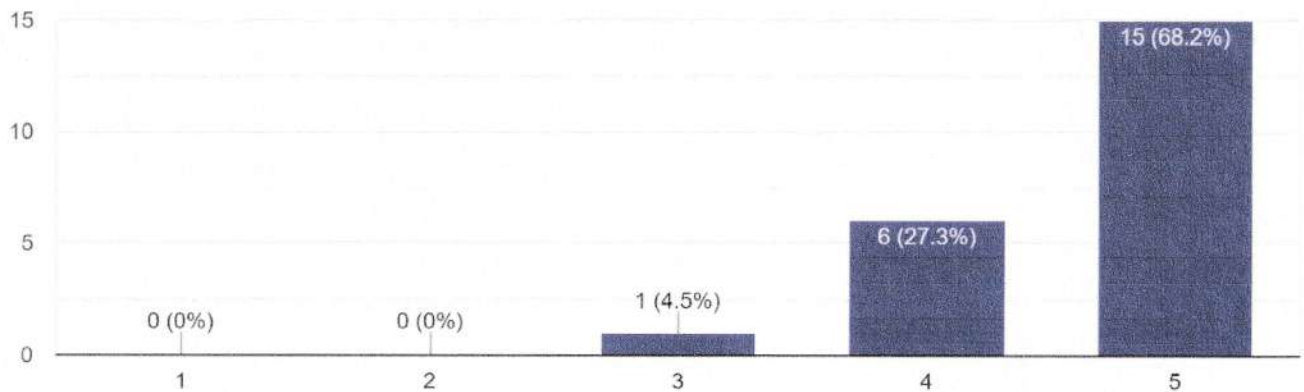
How do you evaluate the usefulness of the session in the future?

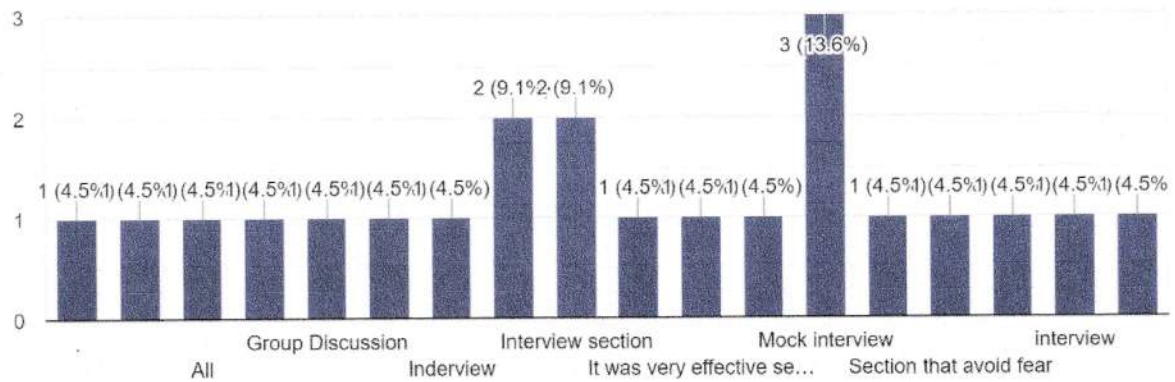
Overall feedback
