REPORT

The Environment Day Celebration of this academic year, HARITHAM 2023 (Widening the Green Horizons to the Neighbourhood), was organised on June 5, 2023. The welcome speech was given by Dr. Sajith K. S. The presidential address was given by Rev.Fr. Dr. Paulachan K, Executive Director/Principal, NIMIT, followed by an inaugural address by Mr. P. C. Biju, President, Koratty Grama Panchayat, by planting saplings in and around the college campus. This function made the students, teachers, and non-teaching staff more aware of the importance of planting trees and nurturing them in order to protect our planet Earth. The formal function ended with a vote of thanks by Ms. Anna Diana, Bhoomitrasena Club Coordinator. There was the planting of saplings in selected houses in the 4 wards of Koratty and Karukutty Panchayat. A ward was assigned to each department, and 3 or 4 students and faculty from the department, along with one of the programme coordinators, went to the assigned wards and planted the saplings. Along with planting six saplings each in each ward, one kit of organic vegetables was also distributed to each ward.

The second event was the planting 50 saplings on the campus of NIMIT on July 13, 2023. The members of the club, with the coordination of Dr. Joy Joseph Puthussery (IQAC Coordinator) and Ms. Sonia Thomas (NAAC Coordinator), gathered at the designated plot near NIMIT Welfare Services to carry out this meaningful activity at 11:30 a.m. The event was named "Zelena," and its aim is to raise awareness among students about the significance of cultivating vegetables. It stands as a commendable effort to instill environmental consciousness and responsibility among the student community.

The third event, "The International Plastic Bag Free Day Celebration" of this academic year, NATUREZA 2023, was organised by the Bhoomitrasena Club on July 12, 2023. The day was celebrated to highlight the importance of taking measures to reduce the usage of plastics for a sustainable, pollution-free, and healthy environment. This year, the International Plastic Bag Free Day puts forward the theme "Beat the Pollution." As part of celebrating the day, the Bhoomitrasena Club conducted a screening of a documentary on plastic pollution, "Blue Planet II." The club also organised an elocution and a postermaking competition on that day.

The fourth event was conducted on September 11, 2023, in which NIMIT collaborated with LIC Chalakudy. The officials from LIC distributed 300 saplings to the institution. The saplings were given to some of the students and staff at the college, and the rest were planted inside the campus.

The fifth one was the sale of organic vegetables, which have been harvested from the campus with the involvement of students. The event is named "Farm Fresh." Vegetable sales happen inside the campus every Monday and Thursday and the harvested vegetables were given to our hostels also. We have cultivated lady finger, tomato, chilli, brinjal, ridge gourd, bottle gourd, yam, tapioca, spinach, raw banana, and banana flower, cauliflower, mango, ginger, Chinese potato, drumstick, powdered turmeric, peppercorn and ash gourd. We have harvested around 853.5 kg of organic vegetables until December 31st, 2023. The students were able to collect Rs 35300/- by selling organic vegetables to the students

and staffs. This event has encouraged them to plant more organic vegetables and extend the programme beyond the campus as well.

The sixth event was organising two competitions on behalf of "Earth Day," celebrated on April 22. We conducted reel-making on the topic "How to Compose Waste" and a photography challenge on the topic "Waste Distribution." This encourages the students to understand the difficulty in composing waste and how to solve this issue. Along with that, they will gain awareness of waste disposal in our state and the aftereffects we are facing due to this. This will make them think about proper disposal of waste and management techniques. The competition was conducted so that the youth, who are our coming generation, could understand and reduce waste dispersion in public areas.
