REPORT

The Training Programme for Bhoomithrasena Club Faculty-in-Charges in Central Zone was held on February 22, 2024, at St. Teresa's College, Ernakulam. Organized by the Directorate of Environment & Climate Change (DoECC), Government of Kerala, the event aimed to enhance the capacity of faculty members leading Bhoomithrasena Clubs (BMCs) in Central Zone. The event commenced with a warm welcome by Ms. Neethu Vijayan, the Bhoomithrasena Club Programme Coordinator at DoECC. Dr. Alphonsa Vijaya Joseph, Principal of St. Teresa's College, Ernakulam, delivered the Presidential Address, followed by the Inaugural Address by Shri. Suneel Pamidi I.F.S., Director of DoECC.

The day-long program included various sessions focusing on different aspects related to environmental conservation and the role of BMCs. Dr. John C. Mathew, Environment Programme Manager at DoECC, set the context for the day's discussions. His session provided an overview of the current environmental challenges and the importance of proactive measures in addressing them. M/s Origami Technologies conducted a session on BMC Web Portal Registration. This training equipped the participants with practical skills to effectively utilize the online platform for managing Bhoomithrasena Club activities and memberships.

Ms. Neenu Susan Paul, a Faculty-in-Charge from St. Teresa's College, Ernakulam, delivered a presentation on the Green Initiatives undertaken by the Bhoomithrasena Club at the college. 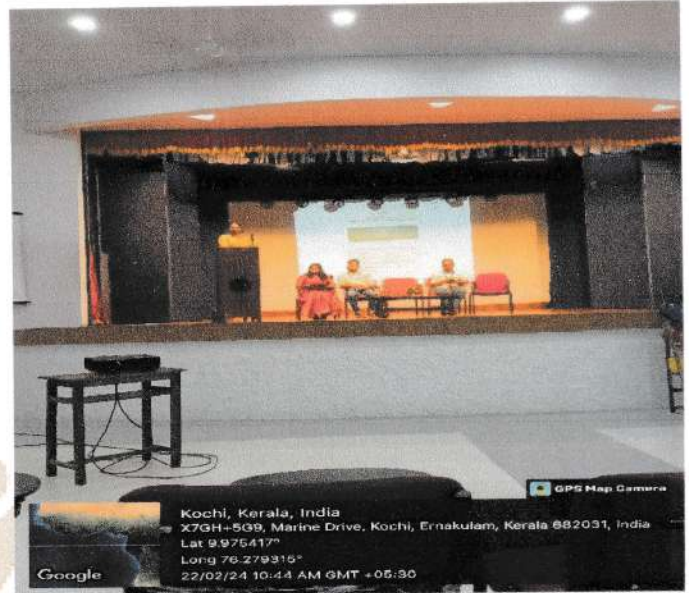


