### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Whereas CHRIST (Deemed to be University) a multi-disciplinary Higher Education Institution, declared under Section 3 of the UGC Act 1956, NAAC 'A+' Accredited offering Undergraduate, Post Graduate and Research Programmes in different disciplines of Humanities, Sciences, Social Sciences, Commerce, Management, Engineering, Architecture, Law and Education at its different campuses, having its Central Campus located at Hosur Road, Bangalore, Karnataka- 560029 (hereinafter referred to as 'CU', which term or expression, unless repugnant to the context, shall include its legal heirs, successors and permitted assigns)

#### And

Whereas Naipunnya Institute of Management and Information Technology, is an unaided institution managed by the Archdiocese of Ernakulam-Angamaly. It is affiliated to the University of Calicut and offers 13 UG and 3 PG programmes. The college is located at Pongam, Koratty East, Thrissur (Dist), Kerala, India and the website https://naipunnya.ac.in/, (hereinafter referred to as 'NIMIT').

Where as CU and NIMIT (hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties') have agreed to enter into a consultancy collaboration for mutual benefit to the constituent stakeholders, particularly for the Students and Faculty Members of the Parties.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into between the Parties from the date of signing this MOU, which witnessed as hereunder.

## Article 1

The purpose of this MOU is to build friendship and goodwill and foster a relationship that will promote mutual intellectual exchanges between students, faculty members and administrators of CHRIST (Deemed to be University) and Naipunnya Institute of Management and Information Technology.





#### Article 2

In an effort to experience the lifelong learning process, both parties are prepared to participate in a formal exchange programme that seeks to promote an academic exchange and provide collaboration in training.

- 2.1. The consultancy will include the following:
  - i. Assistance on offering Add on courses
  - ii. Faculty and student training

## Article 3

- 3.1 All programmes or activities shall lie implemented under the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding and shall be mutually agreed upon in writing, including the necessary budget for the Programmes/activities as and when the need may arise
- 3.2 Both parties are responsible for their own costs in relation to this Memorandum of Understanding unless otherwise mutually agreed.

## Article 4

This MOU may be amended or modified by a written addendum, which will be an undivided part of this MOU and must be properly exchanged and duly signed by the representatives of either Party.

## Article 5

Disputes arising in accordance with the Memorandum will be resolved by consultation and conversation between the Parties, without reference to any third party.

#### Article 6

This MOU enters into validity and effect on the day of its signing by the statutory representatives of the Parties. It shall be effective for a period of 3 (three) years and subject to review may be renewed unless it is terminated by either of the Parties upon prior notice to the other in writing of not less than 3 (three) months before the termination date. However, no such termination shall affect the continuity till completion of the already existing activities under the MOU.

## Article 7

Each Party shall have a Coordinator for the MOU who shall be responsible for organising and implementing this MOU under Article 2 above by connecting with the appropriate Department/s of the Parties. The contact details of the coordinators shall be as stated herein and may be changed by the Parties at any time during the term of this MOU by communication in writing.
