Digi Keralam is a comprehensive digital literacy project that was launched with the main objective of equipping the ordinary people of Kerala to use digital technology and tools. We are pleased to share details of an impactful outreach activity under the 'DiGi Keralam' initiative, focusing on improving digital literacy in Angamaly Municipality. This project, part of a broader effort to enhance digital skills and access, is being conducted by students from the III Semester B.Sc. Information Technology program. The primary goal is to assess and elevate digital literacy within the community. 12 students from III semester B.Sc. Information Technology conducted a survey based on a questionnaire given by Digi App. The central aim of the Digi Keralam Survey is to evaluate the current levels of digital literacy among residents of Angamaly Municipality. By identifying strengths and gaps in digital skills and resources, the initiative seeks to foster improved digital education and provide more effective resources tailored to the community's needs. The data collected through this survey will play a crucial role in shaping future digital literacy programs and interventions.
