## REPORT

After the Blessing Ceremony, Official meeting of CRESCENDO, was held at Navarang auditorium. The meeting commenced with an introductory note delivered by Master of Ceremony. A comprehensive report on Silver Jubilee Initiatives was presented by Ms. Teresa Parackal, Vice Principal, Academics. This achievement would not have been possible without the guidance of our esteemed priests, whose spiritual leadership and unwavering commitment have played a critical role in our academic and institutional growth, shaping Naipunnya into what it is today.

Alongside their guidance, the collective efforts of our faculty, staff, students, parents, and alumni have propelled Naipunnya to new heights. Each one, in their own way, has contributed to our progress, ensuring that we remain true to our values while striving “to reach the unreachable”.

Our journey has been one of growth, challenges and continuous improvement. A testament to this is our remarkable journey from a NAAC grade of B++ to A++, which reflects our commitment to academic excellence and institutional development.

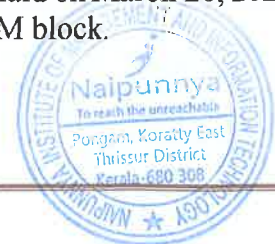
As we reflect on our progress, let us also celebrate the 25 remarkable projects that were announced during the inauguration celebration of Embracium. Let me now take you through these initiatives, which embody our dedication to growth and excellence thus touching lives forever.

- **Vision and Mission Reframing**

In our Jubilee year, we realigned our vision and mission through a workshop led by Rev. Fr. Dr. Vincent Pareppadan S.J. on January 21, 2023, reaffirming our commitment to educational excellence.

- **Infrastructural Development**

The foundation stone for the new cafeteria and Hotel Management block was laid on March 20, 2023. The cafeteria began operating a few months ago, and today we inaugurated the HM block.



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- **Collaborations and Student Development Initiatives**

As part of IEDC activities, a series of orientation sessions and five initiatives were organized to raise awareness regarding innovative startups among students.

- **Earn and Learn Initiatives**

A key highlight of our Jubilee year was the launch of the “Earn While Learn” programmes across various departments, enabling students to earn while learning and gain valuable practical experience. These initiatives include the weekly Friday Market for organic produce and homemade snacks, outdoor catering services, IT apprenticeships, and junior student tutoring, to name a few.

- **Mega Expo, Patenting, and World Records**

As part of Embracium, Hotel Management students showcased their skills by preparing 25 varieties of mandi dishes on November 1, 2022, earning recognition from the Universal World Record Forum. On November 8, 2023, the department created a 10-meter-long chicken tikka for the “Chicken Tikka Challenge 2023,” aiming for records in the LIMCA BOOK OF RECORDS and UNIVERSAL RECORD FORUM.

- **Campus Radio & YouTube Channel**

Naipunnya Digital, the campus YouTube channel, was launched to showcase student talents through creative content.

NIMIT Campus Radio Taal 20.23, the campus radio was launched to provide entertainment and information, for our campus and the local community, with students as RJs.

- **Faculty Development Programmes**

A two-day academic retreat was held on June 27-28, 2022, at Rajagiri College, focusing on ICT in classrooms, outcome-based teaching, research and classroom management to keep our educators at the forefront of excellence.

- **Counseling and Training Centre**

On August 31, 2022, we inaugurated Pratidhi—Naipunnya Centre of Happiness and Wellbeing, dedicated to supporting students, parents, and the local community. This centre plays a key role in promoting mental health and well-being, which we believe is essential for the overall growth and development of individuals.

- **Research and Publications**

The Research Committee was established to ensure quality publications from our faculty. With the college’s support, faculty members have published in UGC journals, Scopus, and Web of Science, along with numerous book publications. Research workshops have also been organized to enhance academic contributions. Naivigyan, the college’s multidisciplinary ISBN research journal, publishes articles from



staff and students. Every year, awards for the Best Project and Best Guide are presented on Aarohan, programme completion ceremony.

- **Community Outreach**

Our college actively engages in community outreach programmes to support local communities and promote social responsibility through various initiatives.

- **Snehasangamam** - Our annual flagship event, brings people from orphanages, old-age homes, and with disabilities to campus and we offer them a platform to showcase their talents, entertain them with games, offer delicious lunch, and provide them with a gift.
- **Rebuild Mission** - This project aimed to build a house for one of our students, and the housewarming ceremony was successfully held on June 10, 2023.

- **Green Campus:** An organic garden was established in collaboration with the Kerala Agriculture Department and Bhoomitrasena Club on December 16, 2022.

- **Employee Enrichment:** Faculty Development Programmes (FDP), Faculty Enrichment Programs (FEP), and training sessions for non-teaching staff were organized.

- **Endowment Lecture Series:** As part of our Silver Jubilee celebrations, we conduct the Mar Antony Cardinal Padiyara Commemorative Lecture Series each year, inviting distinguished guests from various fields to share their expertise and insights.

- **Blended Learning System:** Recognizing the importance of adapting to modern educational trends, our institution implemented a blended learning system to enhance holistic development through online and offline facilitation.

- **Awards and Recognitions** NIMIT received the following honors:  
Excellence in Education from the Minister for Higher Education, Government of Kerala  
Excellence in Student Outreach and Industry Engagement 2023 from ArdorComm Media Group

- **Alumni Chapters:** The connections between Naipunnya and its alumni continue to thrive. In December 2022, we hosted both department-specific and a mega alumni reunion, reuniting graduates from 1998 onwards.

- **E-Assist Program**

The Computer Science Department launched E-Assist in collaboration with Koratty Grama Panchayath to promote e-literacy and raising awareness of e-governance services, helping bridge the digital divide in rural areas. The program was inaugurated on July 1, 2022, by Dr. Jiju P. Alex, Kerala State Planning Board member.

- **La Publica**

This program was launched with the objective of extending library access to the public from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm, allowing community members to utilize our resources.

- **Social tree plantation**

The NSS unit organized a tree planting initiative aimed to raise awareness about the importance of sustainable practices and environmental conservation.

- **Foreign languages/ Competitive exam coaching**

The Foreign Language Cell of the Department of Additional Languages organized classes in French, Italian, and German, with enthusiastic participation from both faculty and students, enhancing language skills and communication abilities. The college also provides coaching for competitive exams like Kerala PSC and UGC NET to help students excel.

- **Health walk & Yoga**

This initiative opens our campus to the public for morning exercise (5:00 a.m. - 6:30 a.m.), with free yoga classes conducted by the Department of Physical Education.

- **Funded Project:** I would like to express my sincere appreciation to the contributors Dr. Antony George, Mr. Anu Rahim and Dr. Viji Vijayan who have made the funded project possible. Their dedication and hard work were essential in bringing this initiative to life.
