### "HER STORY: Journey of Empowerment"

As part of the Women's Day celebrations for 2025, Naipunnya College proudly launched the "Her Story: Journey of Empowerment" initiative. This project, organized by the Women's Cell - Ananya, was designed to honour the inspiring women around us, showcasing their resilience, challenges, and accomplishments. The winning team from I M Com was awarded on College Day with their biopic being showcased as an example of genuine storytelling. The featured woman, Mrs. Lincy Joshy from the winning biopic was presented with the **Above and Beyond Award** by chief guest Dr. Raju Narayanaswamy IAS, recognizing her achievements and contribution to her community. 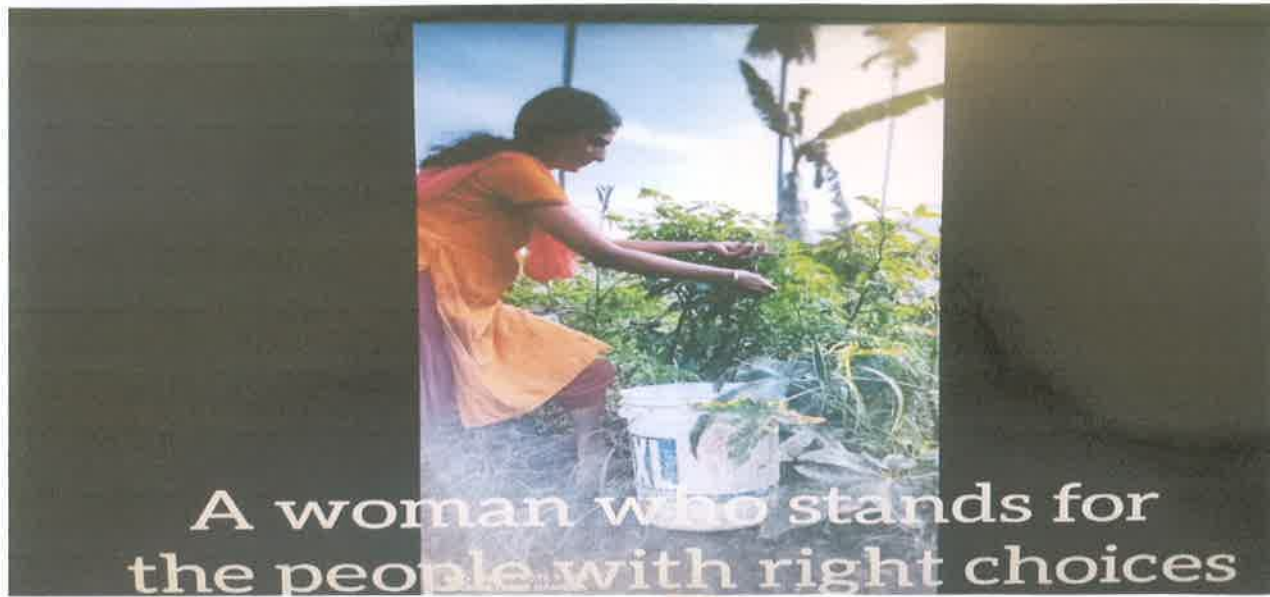

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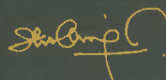

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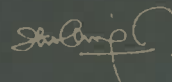
