Report on the One-Day Workshop on Transforming Learning: Outcome-Based Education and Modular Approaches

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Naipunnya Institute of Management and Information Technology (NIMIT), in association with AKCUASC, organized a one-day workshop titled Transforming Learning: Outcome-Based Education and Modular Approaches on 12th December 2024. The event brought together 45 faculty members from colleges across Kerala, fostering a collaborative platform to explore innovative teaching methodologies.

The program commenced with registration at 9:00 AM, followed by an inaugural session presided over by Fr. Dr. Paulachan K J, President of AKCUASC and Principal of NIMIT. The inauguration was graced by Dr. Joseph Injodey, Former Director of Rajagiri Business School, who lit the ceremonial lamp alongside other dignitaries. In his keynote address, Dr. Joseph Injodey highlighted the significance of Outcome-Based Education (OBE) and the collaborative efforts of academic institutions in transforming learning. He also extended heartfelt congratulations to NIMIT for achieving NAAC A++ accreditation in its second cycle. Ms. Teresa Parackal, Vice Principal (Academics) of NIMIT, delivered the welcome address, while Ms. Annie Sebastian, Assistant Professor in the PG Department of English, expressed gratitude with a vote of thanks.

The workshop featured three insightful sessions:

1. Session 1: The first technical session was led by Dr. Sabeen Govind P.V., Assistant Professor at the Department of Computer Science, RCSS. He provided an in-depth exploration of Program Outcomes (POs), Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs), and Course Outcomes (COs), along with their mapping. The interactive session fostered enthusiastic participation and meaningful discussions.

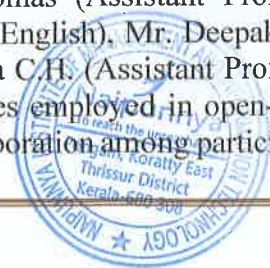
2. Session 2: After a brief tea break, the second session began with an address by Fr. Antony Arackal, Secretary of KCBC and Chairperson of the Albertian Institute of Science and Technology. He emphasized the need for educators to embrace change and foster collaboration in teaching and learning. Following this, Tinchu P. James, Research Officer at the Kerala State Higher Education Council, conducted a session on the transformative changes introduced by the National Education Policy (NEP) and Signature Programs. The session concluded with a lively Q&A segment.

3. Session 3: The afternoon session was moderated by Ms. Sonia Thomas, NAAC Coordinator of NIMIT, and featured presentations by internal resource persons. Ms. Akhila Thomas (Assistant Professor, Department of Hotel Management), Dr. Purnima S. (HoD, PG Department of English), Mr. Deepak K.V. (Assistant Professor, PG Department of Computer Science), and Ms. Vandana C.H. (Assistant Professor, PG Department of Commerce) shared their expertise on pedagogical strategies employed in open-ended modules across disciplines. This session also encouraged idea-sharing and collaboration among participants.

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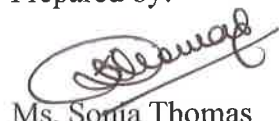

This workshop served as a vibrant platform to advance educational practices, inspiring participants from colleges across Kerala to innovate and transform their approaches to teaching and learning.

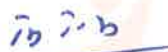
