A peer teaching session was held on 20th August 2024 at 9:55 a.m. by Mr. Joyal Shaji for the students of II B.A. English at Naipunnnya Institute of Management and Information Technology (NIMIT), Pongam, Koratty organised by the PG Department of English. The session focused on the prose piece, "The First Atom Bomb" by Marcel Junod. Mr. Joyal began the session by introducing the historical background of the Hiroshima bombing and the significance of Junod's perspective as a humanitarian and medical professional with the International Committee of the Red Cross.

He highlighted the author's eyewitness account of the devastation caused by the atomic bomb, stressing the ethical implications of warfare and the moral responsibility of humankind. Through vivid imagery and first-hand narration, the text allowed students to reflect deeply on the human cost of scientific advancements misused for destruction.

Mr. Joyal's engaging style and thoughtful questions encouraged active student participation and critical engagement. The class discussed not only the content but also the style, tone, and purpose of the essay. Overall, the session was a successful blend of literature and history, contributing significantly to students' academic and emotional understanding. The initiative was highly appreciated and exemplified the value of peer-led learning.
