On 24th March 2025, a peer teaching session was successfully held at 2:30 p.m. by Ms. Akhila Hari K. V. for the II B.A. English students at Naipunnya Institute of Management and Information Technology (NIMIT), Pongam, Koratty, organised by the PG Department of English. The session focused on Jerome K. Jerome's humorous essay, "Uncle Podger Hangs a Picture."

Ms. Akhila began the session with a brief introduction to Jerome's distinctive style of humour and satire. She then provided an animated reading of the essay, which narrates the comically exaggerated chaos that ensues when Uncle Podger attempts to perform a simple task—hanging a picture.
