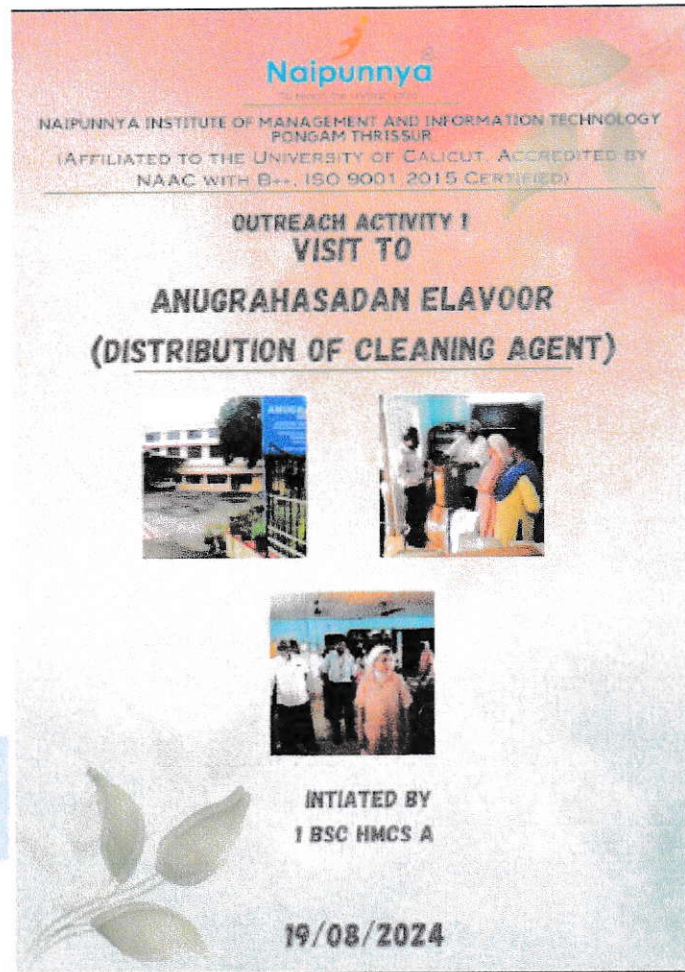

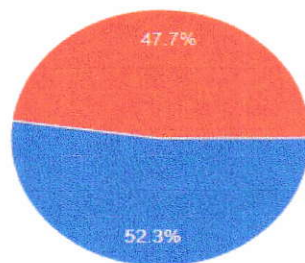

How would you rate the overall organization of the CUSSP activity at Anugrahasadan?

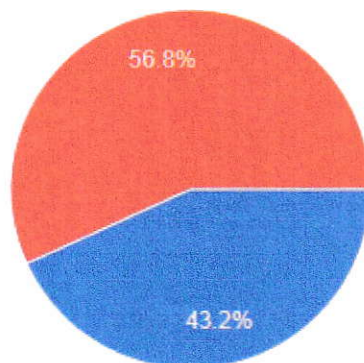

How effective do you think the donation of cleaning items was in supporting the needs of Anugrahasadan?

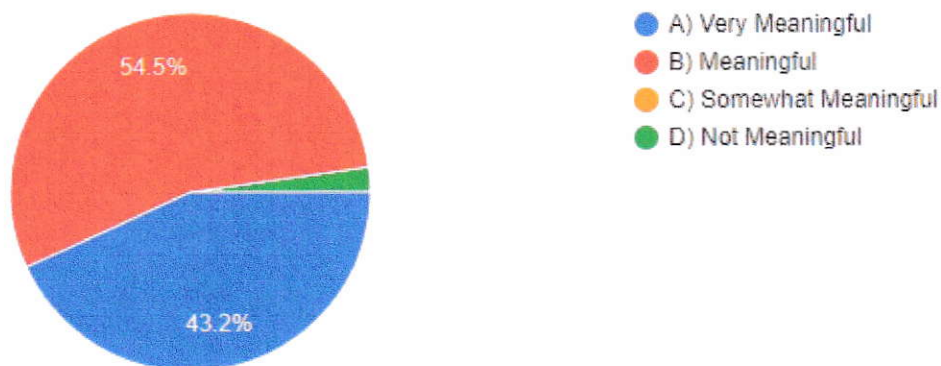

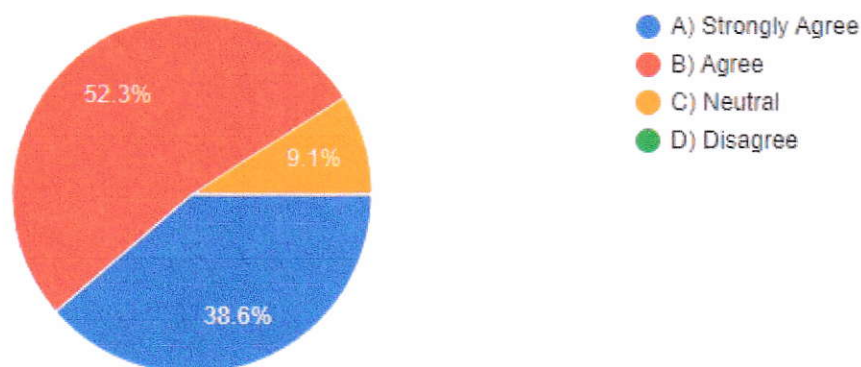
How meaningful was the interaction with the inmates during the visit?

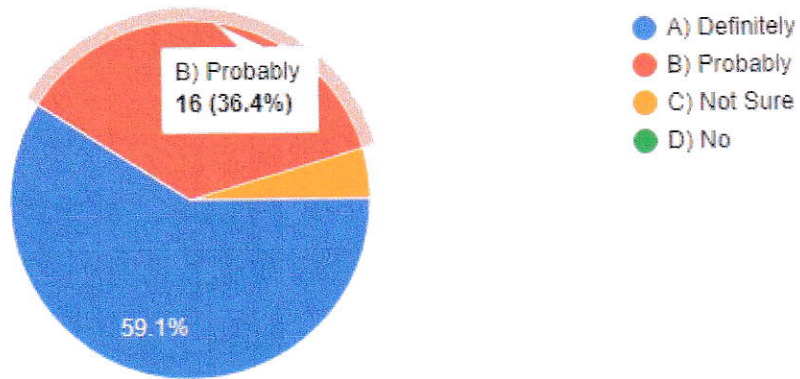

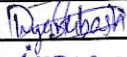
