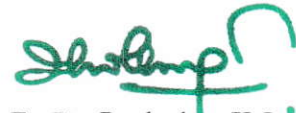

REPORT

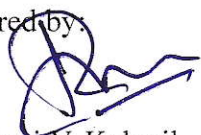
As part of the Second-Semester fieldwork under the Department of Social Work, Naipunnnya Institute of Management and Information Technology (NIMIT), a structured group work program titled “Learn Together, Grow Together” was conducted in Ward 14 of Keezhmad Panchayat on 2nd May, 2025. The group work focused on engaging children in the community through developmental and participatory activities. The main objective was to build leadership, communication, and social skills among children while fostering teamwork and responsibility.

The group was formed with the active participation of interested children, following the principles of group formation and development. A total of five structured sessions were carried out over consecutive days. Each session was designed based on the group work stages: forming, storming, norming, performing, and adjourning. Activities included group games, role plays, discussions, and leadership selection processes, all aimed at developing coordination, cooperation, and self-confidence. Special emphasis was placed on values like mutual respect, decision-making, and collective goal setting.

The sessions also included training on conducting meetings, assigning responsibilities, and documenting proceedings, thereby equipping the children with practical skills for Balasabha formation and functioning. Despite certain challenges like the lack of support from local stakeholders, the group work was effectively facilitated through consistent engagement and trust-building with the children.

The outcome of the group work was highly positive. Children showed improved interaction, enhanced leadership qualities, and better understanding of group participation. It also laid the foundation for forming a Balasabha in the ward, empowering the children to act as active participants in their own development. The group work experience significantly contributed to the professional learning of the MSW students by enhancing their facilitation skills, group observation abilities, and application of group work theories in real-life settings.

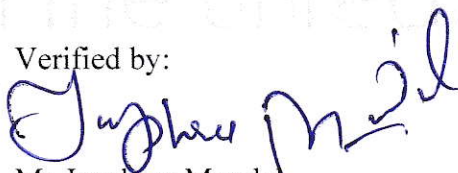
