1. Awareness on Honesty Box Initiative

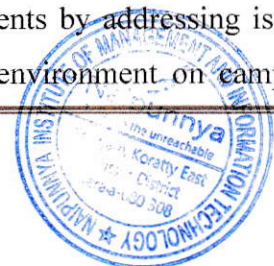

Ananya Women Cell is dedicated to creating awareness on women-centric topics and providing resources to support the female student community.

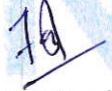
