REPORT

As part of the second semester fieldwork SSW from Naipunnya Institute of Management and Information Technology (NIMIT), a social group work intervention was conducted by forming an educational group called Thejas. The group, consisting of 14 children, was formed in Labour Junction, Moothakunnam a locality under the service area of kottapuram Integrated Development Society(KIDS).

The purpose was to enhance life skills, confidence, and cooperation among children from a marginalized community. The group Thejas was formed by SSW with guidance from Faculty-in-Charge Mrs.Reni V Kalayil HOD Mrs. Joyshree Mondal and Field Supervisor Fr. Siju Varghese. Weekly sessions were conducted using storytelling, drawing, group games, discussions, and reflection activities.

The adjourned stage of the Thejas educational Group marked the successful conclusion of a meaningful group work intervention carried out by MSW students as part of their second semester field work from NIMIT.

The final program was conducted on 29th May 2025 at 2:00p.m. at Labour Junction Moothakunnam, where the group had been consistently working for several weeks. The session began with a prayer song, setting a reflective and respectful tone for the gathering. Emmanuel, the group leader, served as the emcee, confidently leading the program and showcasing the leadership qualities nurtured during the group process.

The event was presided over by the animator KIDS Kottapuram the host organization. As part of the closing celebration, the children actively participated and showcased the talents and skills developed through their time in the group. The performed songs, individual and group dance, delivered speeches, and conducted Life skills based activities, all of which demonstrated the growth they had undergone in areas such as communication, team work, confidence and creativity.

These performances were a reflection of the core life skills that had been imparted throughout the group sessions. Faculty-in-Charge Mrs. Reni V Kalayil and Fr. Siju was present to evaluate the groups progress and outcomes. Their presence and feedback provided a professional assessment of the effectiveness of the intervention. The social work students ensured that the program was well organized and inclusive, arranging tea and snacks for the participants and guests.

The program concluded with the National Anthem at 4:30p.m. marking the end of the group in formal and respectful manner. The adjournment not only celebrated the accomplishment of the children but also gave closure to the group process in a structured and memorable, leaving both the members and facilitators with a sense of achievement and fulfilment.

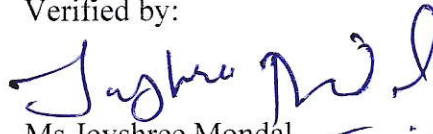
