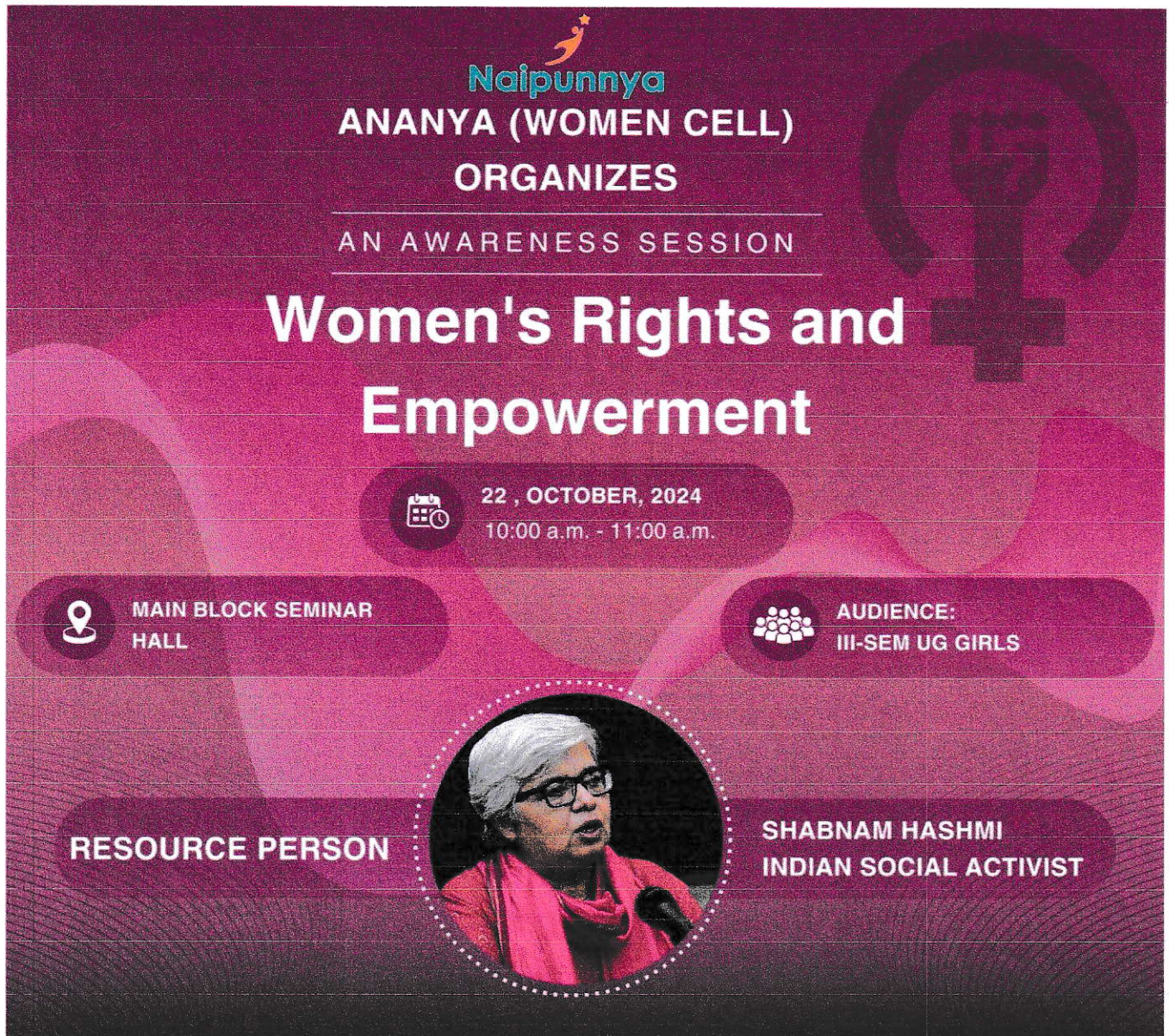

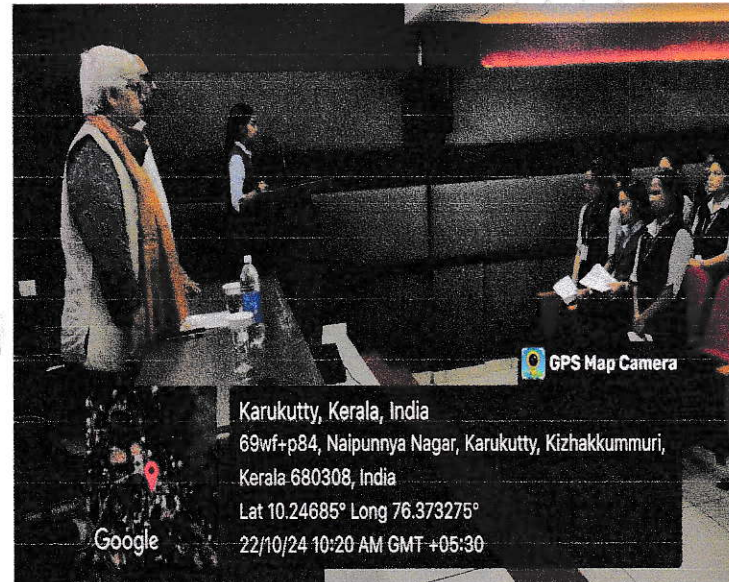


Name: Ms. Shabnam Hashmi
