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## REPORT

The Department of Social Work at Naipunnya Institute of Management and Information Technology (NIMIT), Pongam, observed World Social Work Day on March 18, 2025, with a vibrant and socially relevant program centered on raising awareness about drug abuse. The celebration was designed to educate, engage, and empower both students and the community on one of today's most pressing social concerns.

The day began with a gathering at the Main Block Seminar Hall, where students and faculty came together for a reflective session on the causes, consequences, and prevention of drug abuse. Ms. Anu Biju and Ms. Ancy Joy of I MSW rendered a prayer song to commence the session. This was followed by a welcome address by Ms. Merin B Chiramel (I MSW), who emphasized the importance of the day and the urgency of addressing substance abuse within communities.

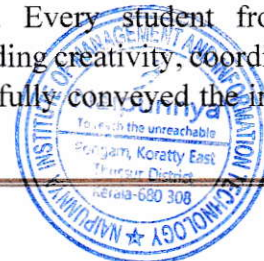
A significant highlight was the awareness session led by Mr. Santhosh T K, Excise Preventive Officer, Irinjalakuda. Drawing from his field experience, he shared insights on how drug addiction affects individuals, families, and society. He also discussed preventive strategies and encouraged students to play an active role in promoting healthy, drug-free lifestyles. As a token of appreciation, Mrs. Joyshree Mondal, Head of the Social Work Department, presented a memento to Mr. Santhosh. Fr. Jith Devassy delivered the vote of thanks, and the session concluded with the National Anthem. Ms. Rose Mary anchored the program and ensured its smooth flow.

Following this session, the students presented a mime performance on the college premises. The mime depicted the devastating effects of drug abuse and emphasized the importance of seeking help and preventive action. It served as a visual and emotional appeal to both students and staff alike.

After the campus performance, the students, accompanied by faculty members, proceeded to Angamaly and Chalakudy for community outreach performances. The first public performance took place at the Angamaly KSRTC Bus Stand, where the mime captured the attention of commuters and passersby. The act illustrated the personal and social consequences of drug use and left a strong impression on the public. Brochures with informative content on drug abuse and prevention were also distributed.

The second performance was held at the Chalakudy Private Bus Stand. The students re-enacted the mime for a new audience, once again drawing in a crowd and delivering a strong social message. The distribution of brochures at this location further extended the reach of the awareness campaign.

Student participation was enthusiastic and commendable. Anu Francis and Ananya Vinod served as student coordinators, ensuring effective organization and performance. Every student from the Department of Social Work contributed to the mime plays, displaying outstanding creativity, coordination, and commitment to social awareness. Their expressive performances powerfully conveyed the intended message.



Faculty members played an essential role throughout the day. Ms. Reni served as the faculty coordinator, offering constant guidance and encouragement. Other faculty members accompanied the students during the outreach activities, providing logistical and moral support and ensuring a safe and productive environment for engagement.
