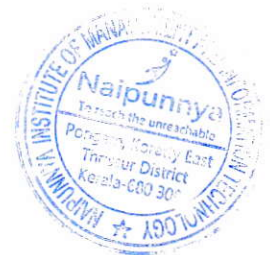
Circular
