With a remarkable academic and literary journey spanning decade, Dr. Muse Mary is widely recognized for her deep intellect, commitment to women's perspectives in media, and her creative voice in Malayalam poetry.

She has published **over 50 articles and poems** in various reputed magazines and has also worked as a **columnist**, offering literary and socio-political insights. Her work consistently reflects a profound engagement with themes such as gender, society, and human psychology.

Dr. Muse Mary served as a **Professor in the Department of Malayalam at Union Christian College, Aluva**, where she mentored numerous students and guided impactful research. 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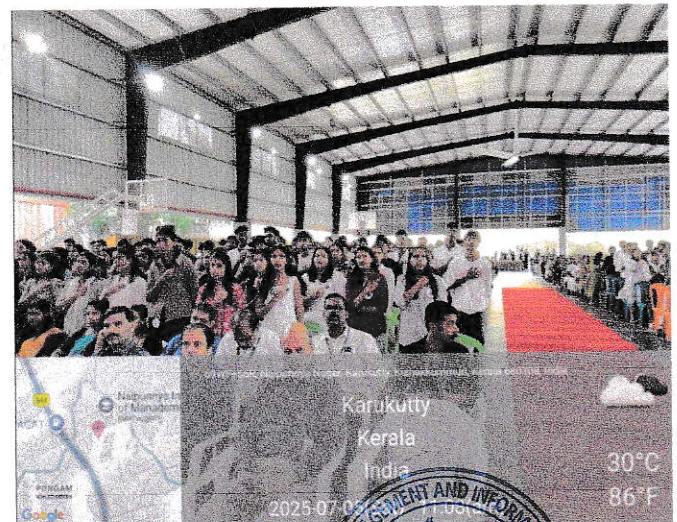
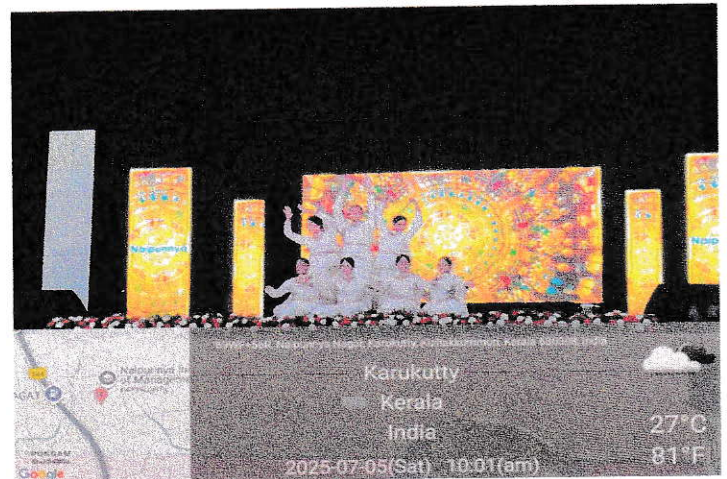
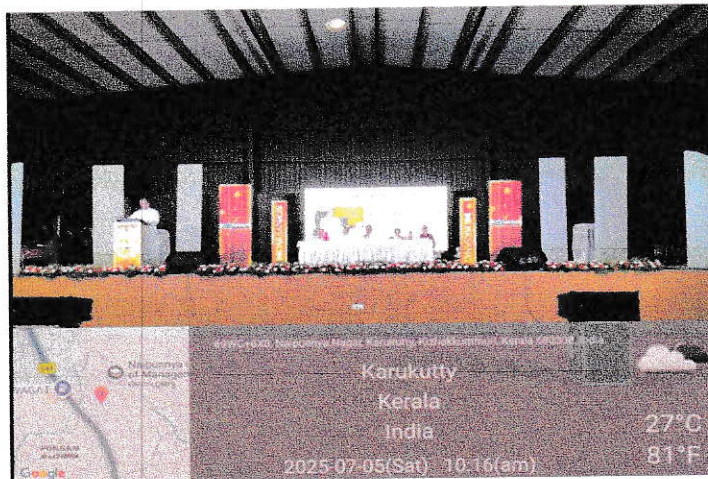
