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REPORT

The Parent Teacher Welfare Association (PTWA) meeting for the first-year UG students was held on 16th, 17th, and 18th September, 2025 at the Navarang College Auditorium. The meetings were conducted department-wise — Computer Science on 16th September, Commerce, Social Work, and Fashion Designing on 17th September, and Hotel Management on 18th September. The programme began with a prayer by a student, followed by a welcome address delivered by the class teacher. Rev. Fr. Dr. Paulachan K. J. delivered the presidential address, emphasizing the importance of parent-teacher collaboration in ensuring the academic success and holistic development of students. The Principal addressed the gathering and spoke about the college attaining autonomous status, which would enhance the academic quality and flexibility of programmes. Dr. Joy Joseph Puthussery, Dean of Studies, interacted with parents and highlighted the importance of effective parenting, grooming standards, and understanding the challenges faced by new-generation learners. Heads of various departments also interacted with parents, clarifying academic and behavioural concerns and sharing insights about the department's initiatives. Feedback collected from parents reflected their satisfaction with the academic progress, discipline, and faculty guidance. They also suggested more frequent academic updates and sessions to enhance students' practical skills. New members were selected for the PTWA Executive Committee during the meeting. After the common session, class wise open house interactions were conducted, allowing parents to discuss their ward's performance directly with class teachers. The overall response was highly positive, marking the meeting as a successful and meaningful interaction between parents and faculty.

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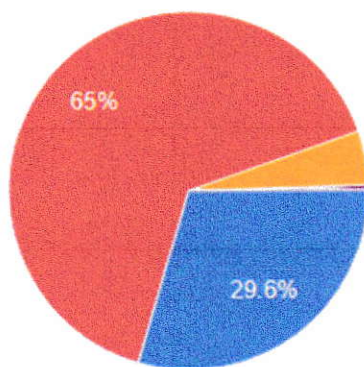

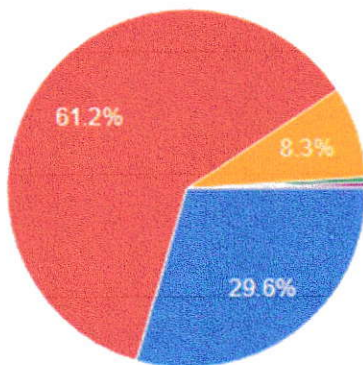

2. The educational service provided by the college is of high quality

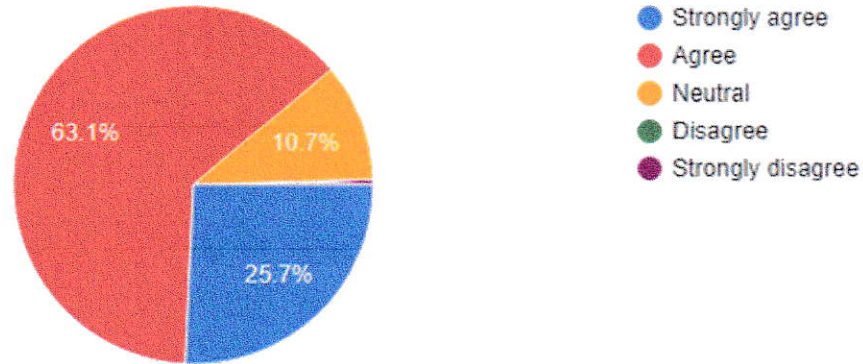

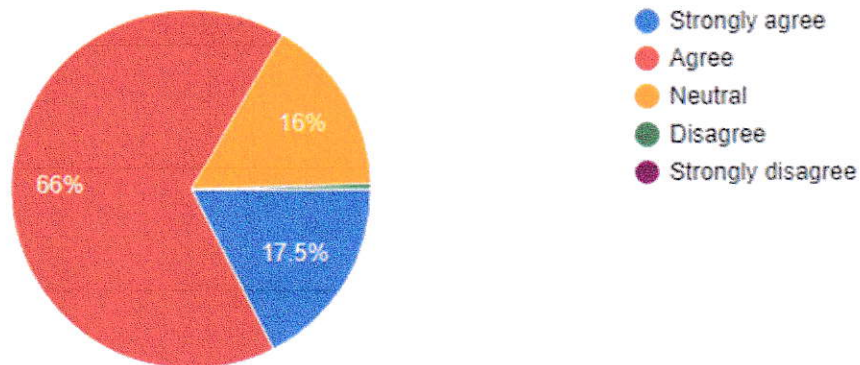
3. The quality of the education provided by the college matches with my expectations

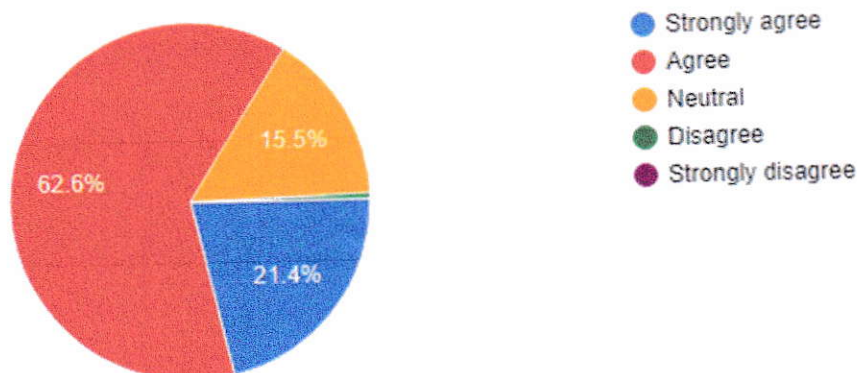

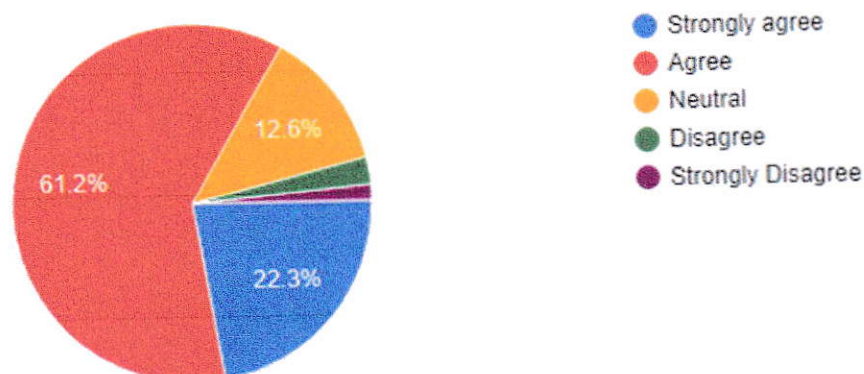

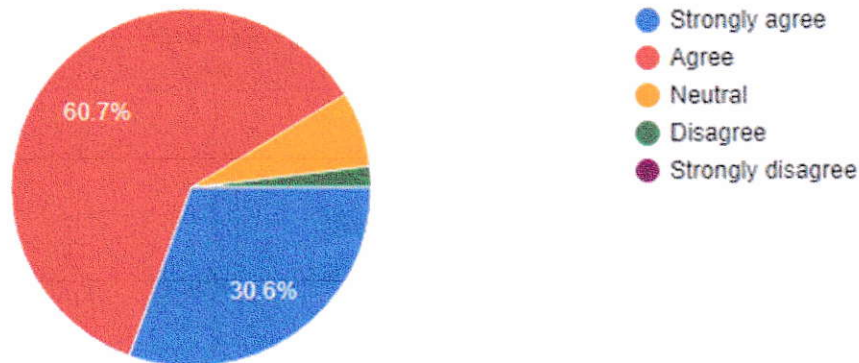

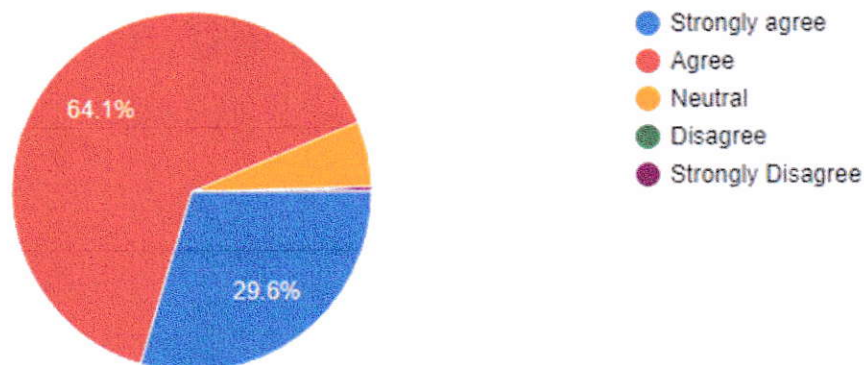

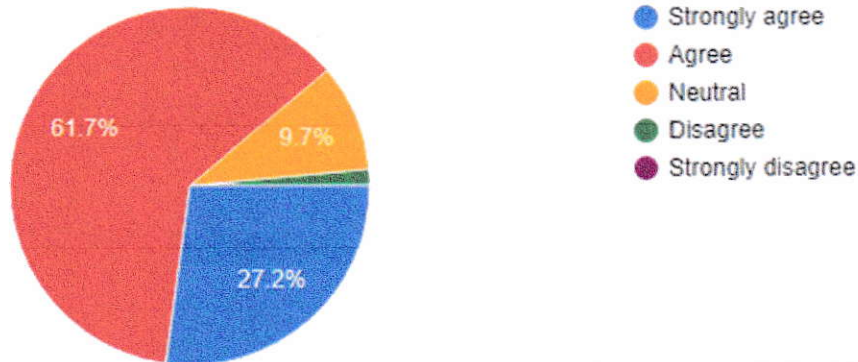

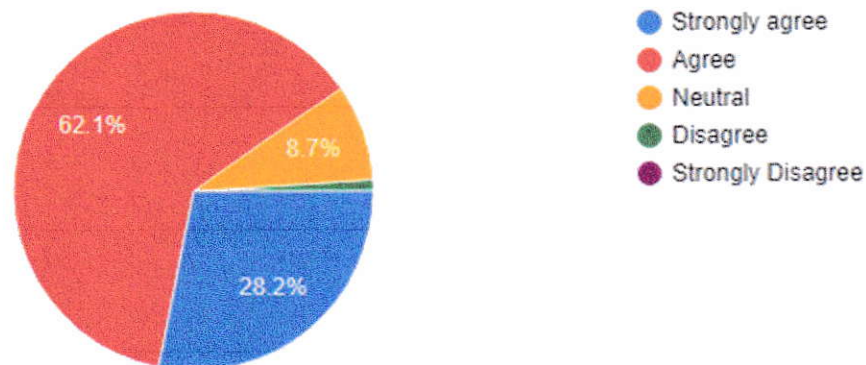
9. The learning atmosphere in the college is good

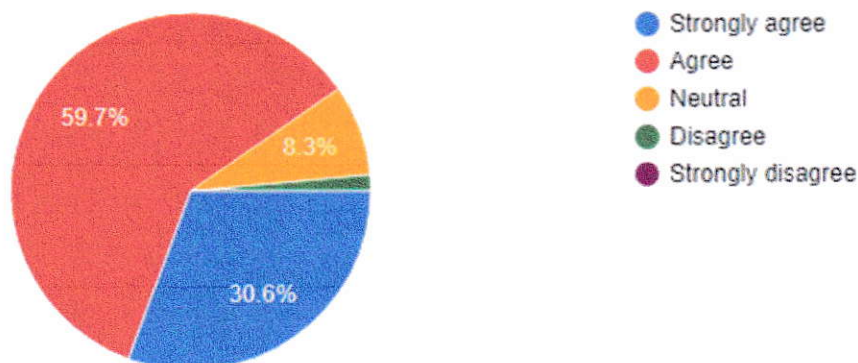

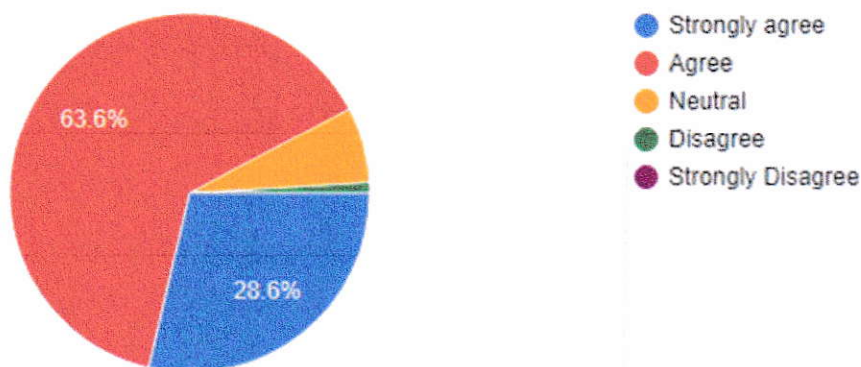

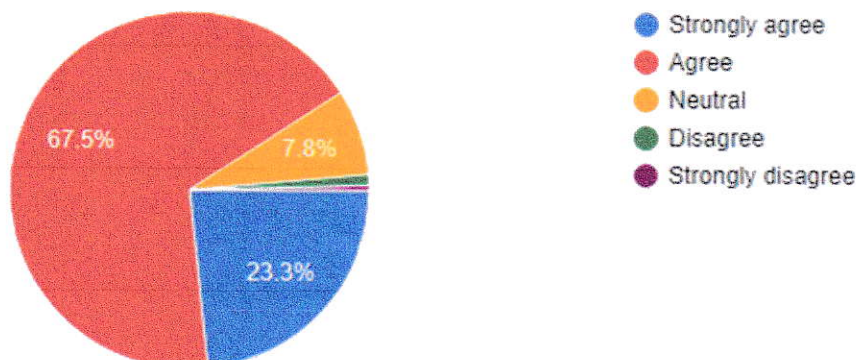
