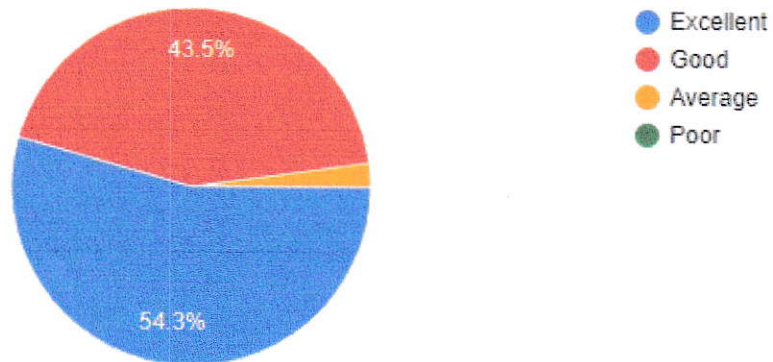

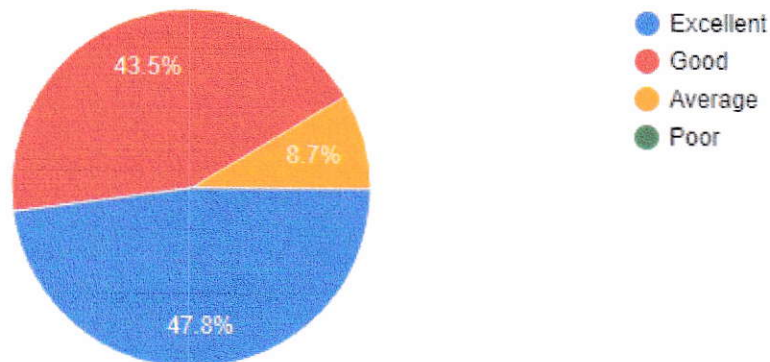

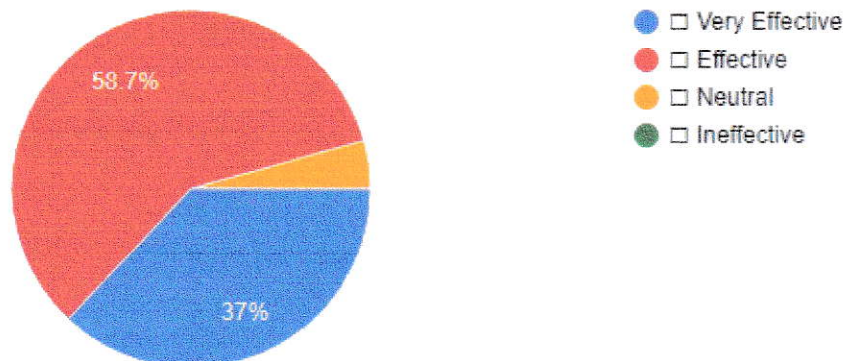
How would you rate the organization of the event?

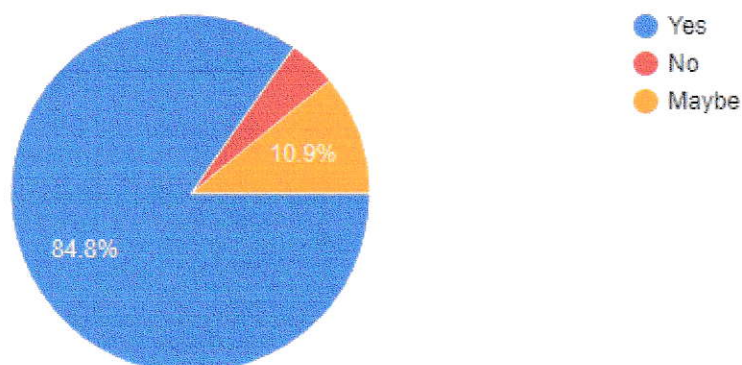
How effective do you think the awareness campaign was?

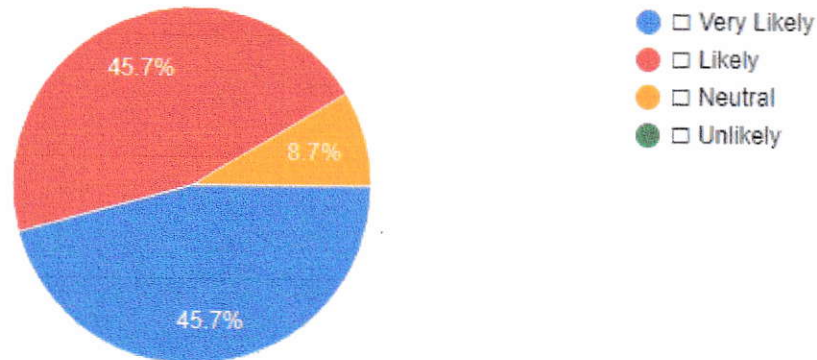
Were you satisfied with the areas that were cleaned?

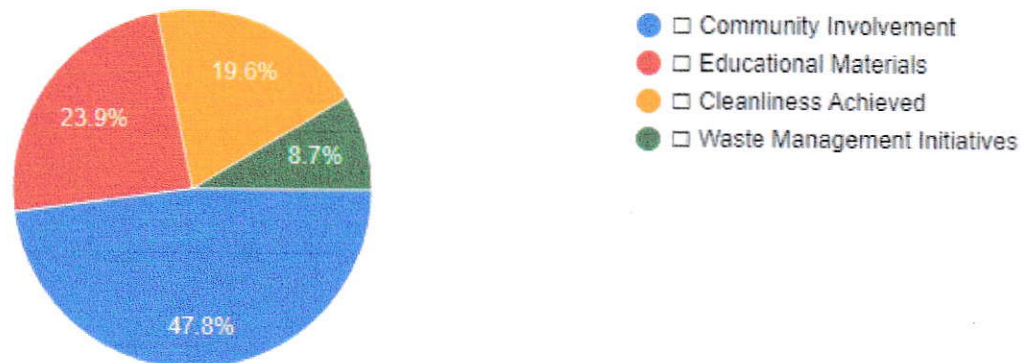
How likely are you to participate in future sanitation drives?

What aspects of the drive did you find most beneficial? (Select all that apply)

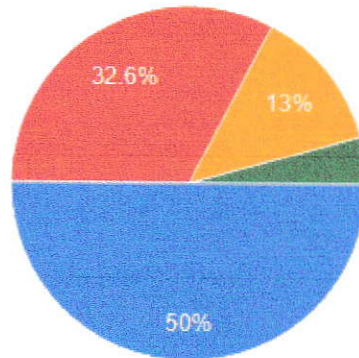
