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REPORT

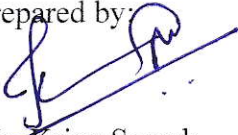

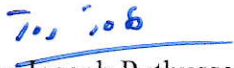
Ten students from various departments actively participated in the three-day residential camp, which focused on leadership development, volunteer engagement, personality enhancement, and social responsibility.

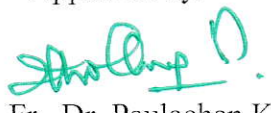
